Q1. Jane bought  $8\frac{3}{8}$  inches of ribbon to decorate her house for her birthday party. She used  $3\frac{1}{8}$  inches of the ribbon. What was the remaining length of the ribbon?

Q2. In an oil refinery,  $21\frac{1}{8}$  litres of oil was poured into a container on Monday,  $34\frac{5}{8}$  litres of oil was poured on Tuesday and  $42\frac{1}{8}$  litres of oil was poured on Wednesday. What was total amount of oil in the container on Wednesday?

Q3. The length of a log of wood was  $8\frac{2}{3}$  meters. A woodcutter cut the log of wood at  $2\frac{1}{3}$  meters to sell to the furniture industry. How long is the log of wood now?

Q4. My father drove to Shimla for our summer vacation. We covered  $3\frac{1}{8}$  km in 1 hour. After taking a tea break we again drove  $5\frac{5}{8}$  km. What was the total distance covered by us?
